- Gen 3 referred to as "serpent
- Job 1:7 And Jehovah said unto Satan, where do you come from?
- Mat 4:3 And the tempter came and said unto him, If you are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread.
- Mat 4:5 Then the devil took him into the holy city;
- Mat 13:19 When any one hears the word of the kingdom, and understands it not, then comes the wicked one
- 2Co 4:4 ...the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelieving,
- Eph 2:2 wherein you once walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the powers of the air, of the spirit that now works in the sons of disobedience;
- Rev 20:2 And he laid hold on the dragon, the old serpent, which is the Devil and Satan


Who is Satan? - SATAN'S BEATITUDES
